I have started review of the application for expansion and renovations at 81 Morning St. The project appears to meet zoning regulations; however, I had a question about the possible encroachment over the property line to the north. Has the property been surveyed? The site plan seems to show the northern edge of the building slightly extending over the side property line. We would have concerns about approving an expansion of a building that is encroaching over a property line without an easement from that abutter. Please let me know any info you may have.

Chris,

We had inadvertently submitted an older drawing for the site plan. The updated plan is attached and properly named.

We referenced the deed and the City's GIS for property boundaries. The property has not been surveyed, but the house and garage have been field measured so as to be located in relation to each other, the retaining wall and fence that runs along two property lines, and the neighboring house. The GIS information was used to establish the relationship of the neighboring buildings that were not easily accessible to measure in the field.

This updated site plan accurately shows our intent of zero increase in footprint (with the exception of the side entry stairs) or overhangs.

Please let me know if you have any other questions or concerns. Thank you for pointing this error out—it was simply an older overlay that we should have updated.
