Conditions:

- 1) The fire alarm technician shall be present for the fire inspection. System acceptance and commissioning must be coordinated with alarm and suppression system contractors and the Fire Department. Call 874-8703 to schedule.
- 2) A master box connection is not authorized for this building.
- 3) A sprinkler supervisory system shall be provided in accordance with NFPA 101, Life Safety Code, and NFPA 72, National Fire Alarm and Signaling Code. Sprinkler supervisory systems shall monitor for water flow and sprinkler supervisory signals via an approved fire alarm panel to central station. One smoke detector shall be located over the panel, a manual pull station located at the front door, and an audible water flow alarm provided. A separate fire alarm permit is required from a certified fire alarm company.
- 4) In field installation shall be installed per code as conditions dictate.
- 5) Supervising Station monitoring for addressable fire alarm systems shall be by point.
- 6) Records cabinet, FACP, annunciator(s), and pull stations shall be keyed alike.
- 7) Notice: The first scheduled final inspection fee is at no charge. Additional inspections shall be billed at \$75 for each inspector.
- 8) Fire protection systems shall be maintained. If system is to be off line over 4 hours a fire watch shall be in place. Dispatch notification required 874-8576.
- 9) Through-penetrations and membrane penetrations in fire walls, fire barrier walls, and fire resistance rated horizontal assemblies shall be protected by firestop systems or devices in conformance with NFPA 101:8.3.5 (ASTM E 814 or ANSI/UL 1479). Providing firestop labels at each firestop system or device and an onsite manual containing the detail for each firestop system or device used for the project will streamline final inspection approvals.
- 10 All smoke detectors shall be photoelectric.
- 11 The installation shall comply with the following:

NFPA 1, Fire Code (2009 edition), as amended by City Code;

NFPA 101, Life Safety Code (2009 edition), as amended by City Code;

City of Portland Fire Department Rules and Regulations;

NFPA 72, National Fire Alarm and Signaling Code (2010 edition), as amended by Fire Department Rules and Regulations; and NFPA 70, National Electrical Code (2011 edition) as amended by the State of Maine

- 12 The fire alarm system shall have a new fire alarm inspection sticker.
- 13 A Knox Box is required for each building.
- 14 The system shall be installed in the same room as the sprinkler riser. An exterior water proof horn/strobe shall be installed adjacent to the sprinkler room door.
- 15 All fire alarm records required by NFPA 72 should be stored in an approved cabinet located at the FACP labeled "FIRE ALARM RECORDS".
