This is fine. Do not worry about the exterior doors; you only need the fire door assemblies between the dwelling units and/or basement and common areas. The existing doors are fine if they have a label on the hinged edge of the door that indicates a 60-minute or greater fire rating. Remember that all fire doors must have 2 self-closing hinges on them. Enjoy the great weather.
