Although we understand your frustration, we cannot input an *incomplete* application. The application checklist is provided to help applicants with what is required for appropriate plan review. If you provide an incomplete application, and do not provide adequate information and plans to show code compliance or appropriate structures, we cannot approve application requests. We have hundreds of applicants in a weeks time and many get their documents appropriately and in time.

Your application is still insufficient. I would suggest scheduling you a sit down with our plan reviewers and they can review everything in your "plan" and what is required. This is a multi-family and requirements are quite stringent. If you are interested in scheduling a plan review meeting, please call us at 874-8703 or respond to this e-mail. We cannot enter this permit as submitted. I have provided you another copy of the permit application with the checklist for your review. I have also attached a "cheat sheet" on porches/decks that may be helpful to you.
