PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Renovating bathroom-not changing the room dimensions-no new walls- demolition to the studs- Replacing window with Anderson double hung 34 wide X 48 high, same rough opening, header not changed, additional three inches accommodated at the bottom of the window – replacing tub with shower and relocated toilet, drain apparatus exists under proposed locations – lavatory moved to opposite side of the room & new drain for sink will tie in easily. Reinforcing frame work where appropriate & reinsulating. Electric radiant floor heat replacing small cast iron radiator.

- ELEVATIONS WITH DIMENSIONS not included -no new walls- only replacing window -Can't determine
 existing framework until wall covering is removed- new window framing will be reinforced other than
 reinforcement, no change of the header required to accommodate the replacement window as the new window
 will just be closer to the floor.
- REPLACEMENT WINDOW = ANDERSON DOUBLE HUNG / 34"w X48"h
