With the issuance of this permit, the owner, builder or their designee is required to provide adequate notice to the city of Portland Inspections Services for the following inspections. Appointments must be requested 48 to 72 hours in advance of the required inspection. The inspection date will need to be confirmed by this office.

- **Please read the conditions of approval that is attached to this permit!! Contact this office if you have any questions.**
- **Permits expire in 6 months. If the project is not started or ceases for 6 months.**
- **If the inspection requirements are not followed as stated below additional fees may be incurred due to the issuance of a "Stop Work Order" and subsequent release to continue.**
- **Per Section 107.3.1 of the Maine Uniform Building and Energy Code (MUBEC). One set of printed approved stamped construction documents shall be kept at the site of work and shall be open to inspection by building officials.**

<b>Conditions:</b>			
1) 108.2 Conformance. Temporary structures and uses shall conform to the structural strength, fire safety, means of egress, accessibility, light, ventilation and sanitary requirements of this code as necessary to ensure public health, safety and general welfare.			
108.3 Temporary power. The building official is authorized to give permission to temporarily supply and use power in part of an electric installation before such installation has been fully completed and the final certificate of completion has been issued. The part covered by the temporary certificate shall comply with the requirements specified for temporary lighting, heat or power in NFPA 70.			
Equipment shall be installed in compliance with the manufacturer's specifications and the UL listing. This permit DOES NOT authorize any construction activities. The tent/stage must be removed at the end of the event.

<b>Conditions:</b>			
1) Cooking within the tents has not been reviewed and approved.			
2) Fuel-fired heating equipment and propane tanks shall be installed outside of the tents and not within 5 feet of the tents or an exit discharge.			
3) Tents shall have an approved fire resistant rating and maintain 10' between stake lines. No smoking or open flame allowed within 10'. Provide at least one 2A:10 BC fire extinguisher.			
4) If the sides of the tents are to be enclosed at least two remotely located and marked exits shall be provided.			
5) All tents shall meet the flame propagation performance criteria contained in NFPA 701. A certificate or other evidence of acceptance by an organization acceptable to the AHJ shall serve as evidence that the tent fabric materials have the required flame propagation performance.			
6) All means of egress to remain accessible at all times.			
7) All construction shall comply with 2009 NFPA 101, Chapter 11 Special Structures and High Rise Buildings..			
8) All construction shall comply with 2009 NFPA 1, Fire Code. Review and approval by the AHJ shall not relieve the applicant of the responsibility of compliance with this Code (Chapter 1.14.4).			
9) All construction shall comply with City Code, Chapter 10.
