The meeting convened with an introduction of the site plan and architectural design by William Conway, Sebago Technics and Michael Coyne, Archetype Architects.

Approximately six members of the public attended the meeting; following are the topics discussed:

- Building materials proposed are fiber cement siding, metal panels and wood elements to accent building entrances. Final design and color selection pending Planning Board review.
- 2. Building will have a central corridor with units facing Washington Avenue and Anderson Street.
- 3. Building width approximately 68 feet, all living areas and bedrooms will have windows and natural lighting.
- 4. Construction of the project will be challenging given the sloping terrain. At the rear of the building a retaining wall will be constructed to create a level platform for the building. The retaining wall will be built using precast concrete segmented blocks with grid reinforcing. The face of the wall will be textured for an appearance of natural stone. Many noted this is common in the neighborhood.
- 5. The building will not block any views from existing nearby homes.
- 6. Many complimented the project and stated it will be a nice improvement to the neighborhood.
- 7. The applicant has yet to determine if units will be condos or apartments, and price ranges have not been determined.

The meeting concluded at approximately 6: 15 PM.
