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Hi there,

Thank you for your patience. I got all the dimensions, exits, and other information for the permit. I have reattached everything in case you do not have it in addition to the new plot map. Here are some details on the map:

- tent is 40'x60'
- it is being set up in the Urban Farm Fermentory front lot
- dimensions on the map include distance from street, distance from shrubbery, distance from building, distance from trees, and distance from nearest edge of lot.
- there is no temporary staging
- the tent is open on all sides, so there are not designated entrance/exit points.

Since the lot is not owned by the City, I believe we do not need to provide insurance for the tent, correct?
