Thanks for clarifying the size of the free standing sign panel that you are using. On the document that outlined the signs, you showed sign #1 & sign #3 as the same sign. Since sign #1 is 5' x 8' and you did not state what size sign #3 was I assumed it was also 5' x 8'. Now I understand that it will be 4' x 5' or 20 sf and the total square footage of the freestanding sign is 40 sf. The pictures also helped clarify things. Now all I need the height of the sign and I should be able to sign off.

I will take a photo of the building/free standing pillar tomorrow and send it over asap. Regarding your questions:

"You are proposing to have 40 sf on the free standing sign." : I'm only proposing to use 20sq ft on the free standing piller, replacing the 20 sq.ft "ART" sign, with our 20 sq.ft. hand painted plywood sign.

"Is this in addition to the exisitng two 20 sf signs?": No, we intend to replace the current plywood, or paint directly over the 20 sq.ft. "ART" Sign

"This would be a total of 80 sf on the free standing sign which is over what is allowed.": There will still only be 40sq.ft of signage on the free standing pillar.

"Also, how tall is the free standing sign from grade to the top?" : I will measure that tomorrow, and let you know via email.
