To Whom It May Concern:

An evaluation of the property at 19 Hammond St 08/17/99 revealed that the structure fails to comply with Section 111.4 of the 1996 BOCA Code of the City of Portland.

1. Property boundaries not established.
2. Storm drain and plumbing not included in approved plans

This is a **STOP WORK ORDER** pursuant to Section 117.1 of the Building Code(1996 BOCA). All construction activity must Stop immediately.

1. Clearly establish and mark property boundaries.
2. Amend permit to include plumbing or remove plumbing

Therefore, you are required to submit amended construction and site plans to this office for review and approval. You must also submit a list of all subcontractors on the job with their addresses and telephone numbers. When you have received approval of the amended plans and submitted the requested subcontractor information you may request removal of the "STOP WORK" order.

Failure to comply will result in this office referring the matter to the City of Portland Corporation Counsel for legal action and possible civil penalties, as provided for in Section 1-15 of the Code and in Title 30-A M.R.S.A. ss 4452.

This constitutes an appealable decision pursuant to Section 121.5 of the Code. Please feel free to contact me at 874-8707, if you wish to discuss the matter or have any questions.
