
This office has received numerous complaints regarding the condition of your property located at 37 Madison Street, Portland, Maine.

The City must now consider the option of placing this property on the demolition list unless you can provide us with a plan to restore this structure and a time frame indicating how you intend to accomplish this task. I feel that the building, as is, can be considered a dangerous structure under state statute 17-2851.

If I do not hear from you within 10 days of receipt of this letter, but no later than September 25, 1995, I shall be forced to proceed with a demolition order.
