This letter is to confirm that there should be an adequate supply of clean and healthful water to serve the needs of the proposed 4 bedroom duplex located at 72 Walnut Street in Portland. According to District records, there is a 20" cast iron water main on the north side of the street as well as a hydrant located 135 ft from the site.

The current data from the nearest hydrant indicates there should be adequate capacity of water to serve the domestic water needs of your proposed project, as stated in your letter, dated March 1, 2009.
