Hi Jonathan,

I am in the process of reviewing your application for demolition and renovation at 6 Oxford St, but there a couple issues I need to touch base with you about. First, the project cannot qualify for fast-track because it involves exterior demolition and is therefore not purely a renovation "within the existing shell."

Second, I wanted to confirm that the proposal is to demolish the rear addition (which contained an enclosed stairway) and replace it with an exterior open stairway? This may be a concern under the building code requirements, but we need more information in order to fully assess the application, including:

- Plot plan showing the lot lines and the setbacks of the new stairway from all property lines
- Exterior elevation views of the existing and proposed rear of the structure
- · Cross sections with framing details for the new exterior wall
- Stair details (tread depth and height, rise/run, guards/handrails, baluster spacing, footing information) and landing details (pier layout, fastenings, guards)

If you can e-mail these additional plans to me, we will continue with the permit review.

Please let me know if you have questions about this.

Per the building permit #638 submitted for 6 Oxford Street, I would like to exclude the removal of the rear section at this time and only include the renovations within the existing structure, so as to qualify for fast-track approval.

The exterior work portion of the original application (tearing off the back section of the building) shall be split out and re-submitted as a separate/secondary application for permit.

All new interior partition walls, (none of which are load bearing) will be 2x4 KD spruce/pine 24" on center with 1/2 sheetrock.

Please confirm your receipt of this request and let me know if there is anything else I need to do to gain approval for interior work.
