A recent inspection of your property by a Supervising State Fire Inspector revealed the existence of conditions which are in violation of the laws pertaining to fire and structural safety.

Accordingly, the following steps are to be taken to remedy these conditions:

1. Rehang front door to open with traffic.
2. Exit doors to have anti-panic hardware installed.
3. Provide emergency lighting to cover exits.
4. Boiler room to be enclosed with one hour fire resistant material. Room to have self-closing door and air for boiler to be taken directly from the outside.
5. Rear room to have second exit and room not to be used until this is provided.
6. Remove all padlock hasps and draw bolts from exit doors at once.
7. Maintain at least 3 ft. aisles between tables.
8. A dance license must be secured before any more dancing on the premises.

Please advise this office within ten days of the action which you propose to take.

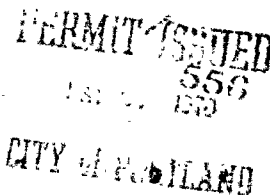

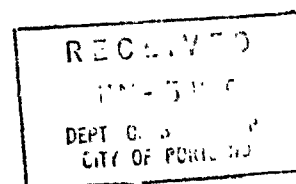

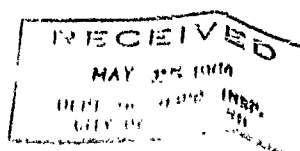

Dear Mr. DiPietro:

It has come to the attention of this department that you have applied for a license to operate a billiard and pool room in the vacant store at 227 Congress Street. This property is located in a B-2 Business Zone where under the provisions of Section 9-A-3 of the Zoning Ordinance a billiard and pool hall is excluded from the uses allowable in that type of zone.

A certificate of occupancy is required from this department for establishing such a use in addition to the license required for its operation. Under the circumstances such a certificate cannot be issued unless and until the use is authorized by the Board of Appeals.
