I had hoped to have the windows in and the ice cream flowing for the 4th. Obviously that is not going to happen. I just wanted to point out that by not being a squeaking wheel I have probably cost myself thousands of dollars. I hate bugging you and asking for favors as I know you are swamped with applications. It would seem to me the new/old method of just "blow out the easy ones and get 'em out of here" seemed to be working much better- at least for smaller "contractors" such as myself.

The three windows I wanted to add as an amendment (your recommendation) was originally submitted in April, re-submitted in May with corrections with the permit paid for on May 26th. Of course from my perspective it seems this is a fairly simple application and expected a quick turn around, so now I am going to ask a favor and have you to please try and get it cleared so we can put the windows in, get inspected and get open. It's killing me.
