Reduced plans or electronic files in PDF format are required if originals are larger than 11" x 17".
Per State Fire Marshall, all new bathrooms must be ADA compliant.
Separate permits are required for internal and external plumbing, HVAC & electrical installation

For additions less than 500 sq. ft. or that does not affect parking or traffic, a site plan exemption should be filed including:
