Hi Nell – I find the fence detail to be acceptable. I find it very difficult to understand the proposed apron/curb work. The plans note a 1.45' section of new curb. Too short. Have them provide a clear detail. While not in our standards, we are asking applicants to provide a maximum 2% accessibility route along the sidewalk. I would like to see if that can be incorporated.
