- 1. The appeal applicant is Robert VanWert.
- 2. The subject property is located at 34 Howard Street, Portland, Maine.
- 3. The Property is located in the R-6 Zone.
- 4. The appellant received a building permit for a structure on July 14, 2017.
- 5. This appeal is from a Notice of Violation dated March 3, 2018.

The Board also makes the following CONCLUSIONS:

- 1. The Board concludes that it has jurisdiction pursuant to 30-A M.R.S. § 2891(4) as this is an appeal from a Notice of Violation that was filed within 30 days of the date of that Notice of Violation. (Vote: 7-0 in favor).
- 2. The Board also GRANTS the appeal of the applicant and finds that *Juliano v. Town of Poland*, 1999 ME 42, does apply to this appeal and that the City was required to appeal the building permit within 30 days of the date of the permit. (Vote: 5-2 in favor).
