

NOTES:

Character of Brick Walk: Brick is laid in Running Bond pattern with edges being full-sized brick (where possible) moving into adjacent beds. Preparation should include a 5" base with a 2" stone dust setting bed.

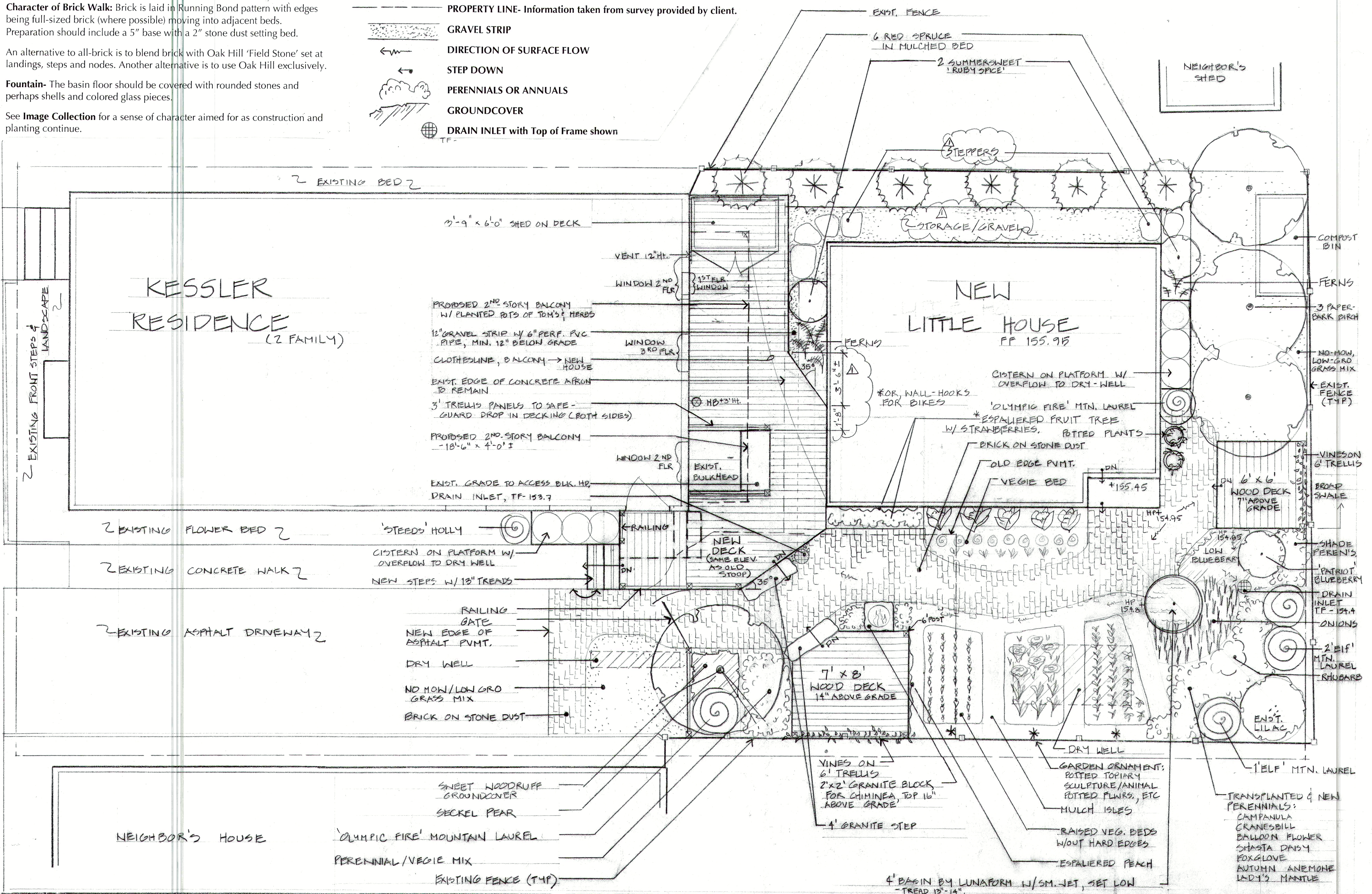
An alternative to all-brick is to blend brick with Oak Hill 'Field Stone' set at landings, steps and nodes. Another alternative is to use Oak Hill exclusively.

Fountain- The basin floor should be covered with rounded stones and perhaps shells and colored glass pieces.
