## We propose the following scope of work:

1. Basement		\$1,577
a. Install beams and suppo	orts to shore up the existing framing in the base	ement.
b. Remove and replace dar	maged sections of framing	
c. Properly support filled in	sections of floor framing.	
d. Add supports in crawl sp	pace for kitchen are floor	
2. Exterior		\$8,853

- a. Replace rear rotted sill on the building. This includes lifting the rear wall as much as possible to accommodate appropriate framing members.
- b. Install headers and framing for a new french door leading to the rear yard. Install new french doors with hardware. An allowance of \$1,000 is included for the purchase of the door and hardware
- c. Build an 11' x 16' free standing patio deck at the rear of the house with pressure treated framing and synthetic decking.
- d. Relocate the side exterior door to the location of the adjacent window. An allowance of \$400 is included for the purchase of the door and hardware.
- e. Remove the existing front door and frame the door opening to accommodate a new door. Install the new door and hardware. An allowance of \$1200 is included for the purchase of the door and hardware.
- f. Relocate the existing window in the living room to accommodate a larger mud room area. Frame in and sheath the old opening. (New window by others)
- g. Remove the side door that currently goes to the second floor stairway. Frame in and sheath the old opening. (possibly add window in this location, doesn't affect the cost of this item other than the cost of an additional window)

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	h.	Build new stairs from the second floor deck to the ground level to provide a second means of egress to the second floor unit. Stairs will have 1 landing and will be constructed of pressure treated materials similar to the existing deck.

	d.	Install a support beam with posts and fasteners to carry the loads left by the existing small bedroom wall
