<b>Violation</b>	<b>Proposed Date of Completion</b>
<b>NFPA 10- 7.1.1 FIRE EXTINGUISHERS NEED ANNUAL SERVICE;</b> The owner or designated agent or occupant of a property in which fire extinguishers are located shall be responsible for inspection, maintenance, and recharging. Fire Extinguisher in the laundry room needs to be inspected or removed.	
<b>NFPA 70- ARTICLE 314.28 OPEN ELECTRICAL JUNCTION BOX;</b> Boxes and conduit bodies used as pull or junction boxes shall comply with 314.28 (A) through (D). In basement. As you go down into the basement, the room on the left side. Junction box in the ceiling area above the chimney clean out, needs cover.	
<b>NFPA 101- 8.3.5 HOLE IN WALL NEEDS REPAIR;</b> The provisions of 8.3.5 shall govern the materials and methods of construction used to protect through-penetrations and membrane penetrations in fire walls, fire barrier walls, and fire resistance-rated horizontal assemblies. The provisions of 8.3.5 shall not apply to approved existing materials and methods of construction used to protect existing through-penetrations and existing membrane penetrations in fire walls, fire barrier walls, or fire resistance-rated horizontal assemblies, unless otherwise required by chapters 11 through 43. In basement, As you go down into the basement, the room on the left side. The hole in the wall of an old chimney, just above the clean out. Appears to be the old flue pipe. Chimney appears to be full of old shingles. Needs to be bricked up.	

## **VIOLATOR CERTIFICATION**
