

WARRANTY DEED
(Maine Statutory Short Form)

KNOW ALL BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, **DOLORES M. WILHOITE**, of Portland County of Cumberland, and State of Maine, for consideration paid, GRANT to **MELISSA** whose mailing address is 68 Main Street, Rockport, ME 04856, with **WARRANTY COVENANTS**, certain real estate located in Portland, County of Cumberland and State of Maine, which is more particularly described as follows:

A certain lot or parcel of land with the buildings thereon, situated on the easterly side of St. Lawrence Street in said Portland, being numbered 37 on said street by land now or formerly of Crocker, northeasterly by land now or formerly of Sargent, southeasterly by land now or formerly of Goding, southwesterly by St. Lawrence Street.

Being the same premises conveyed to Dolores M. Wilhoite and Tracy Wilhoite from Mary D. Kalicky, Personal Representative of the Estate of Clorinda DiBiase by Deed of Sale Personal Representative dated May 9, 1996 and recorded in the Cumberland County Register of Deeds in Book 12499, Page 41. Tracy Wilhoite died on August 2, 2010, and Dolores M. Wilhoite is the surviving joint tenant.

This conveyance is made **SUBJECT, HOWEVER**, to real estate taxes which are now due and payable, which, by acceptance hereof, Grantee assumes and agrees to pay.
