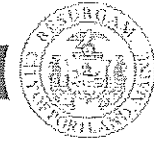

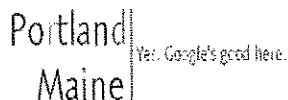

Hi Tori,

Thank you so much for getting back to me and keeping this moving along in the right direction. All the required work is done except 2 more fire doors, one for the basement and one for the front door of the second floor apartment, (mine). The clutter has been removed in the basement and hallways, all 3 apartments are hardwired with smokes and the necessary carbon monoxide alarms and I have installed sprinklers above all 3 gas furnaces in the basement. I have had real difficulty finding available workers to do these last 2 doors, especially for a reasonable price. I believe that in the colder months it will be easier to find someone available.

I will have the remaining required work done, i.e. 2 remaining fire doors installed, by January 2017. Then all fire safety code violations will be fully remedied as outlined after the inspection.
