Dear Mr. Rice:

We recently received a complaint and an inspection was made by Code Enforcement Officer Merlin Leary of the property owned by you at 182 Congress Street , Portland, Maine. As a result of the inspection, you are hereby ordered to correct the following substandard housing conditions:

- * 1. Trash stored in the rear hall stairway. 108-4
- * 2. Inoperative ceiling light on the front hall stairway and the bathroom ceiling. 113-5

The above mentioned conditions are in violation of Article V of the Municipal Code of the City of Portland, Maine, and must be corrected on or February 11, 1988.

Failure to comply with this order may result in a complaint being filed for prosecution in District Court.
