- 1) Hardwired photoelectric interconnected battery backup smoke detectors shall be installed in all sleeping rooms, protecting outside these rooms, and on every level. The same is required for existing buildings undergoing alterations, hard wired to the electrical system. Interconnection is required, where permanent wiring is feasible, which shall be verified upon inspection.
- 2) The review of this permit did not include a review or confirmation of the zoning legal use. It is only approving the specific work described in the plans and forms submitted. The current use of the property may be found to be unlawful.
- 3) Separate permits are required for any electrical, plumbing, sprinkler, fire alarm, HVAC systems, heating appliances, including pellet/wood stoves, commercial hood exhaust systems, fire suppression and fuel tanks. Separate plans may need to be submitted for approval as a part of this process.
- 4) Per the 2009 IRC Sec. R305 and the 2015 UPC plumbing code, bathrooms shall have a ceiling height of 6'-8" at the center of the front clearance (24") at the sink and toilet and at the showerhead above a minimum area of 30"x30".
- 5) Carbon Monoxide Alarms: Where required in existing dwellings. Where work requiring a permit occurs in existing dwellings that have attached garages or in existing dwellings within which fuel-fired appliances exist, carbon monoxide alarms shall be provided in accordance with Section R315.1.
- 6) This permit is being approved on the basis of plans submitted. Any deviations shall require a separate approval before starting that work.

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
