





DEMO - ATTIC PLAN

DEMOLITION NOTES:

- 1.) ALL HAZARDOUS MATERIALS TO BE REMOVED AND DISPOSED OF IN ACCORDANCE WITH ALL FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL REGULATIONS.
- 2.) REMOVAL ALL UNUSED PLUMBING, ELECTRICAL, AND MECHANICAL ELEMENTS THAT ARE NOT PROPOSED TO BE REUSED
- 3.) REMOVE ALL LAYERS OF FINISHED FLOORING AND FURRING DOWN TO SHEATHING
- 4.) REMOVE ALL CEILINGS AND STRAPPING TO JOISTS AS WELL AS ANY IN CEILING ELEMENTS SUCH AS INSULATION, ETC.
- 5.) IF ANY ELEMENTS TO BE REMOVED ARE FOUND TO BE STRUCTURAL, THE G.C. SHALL NOTIFY THE ARCHITECT IN WRITING PRIOR TO REMOVING SUCH ELEMENTS
- 6.) REMOVE AREAS OF FLOOR, WALLS, CEILINGS AND ROOF AS REQUIRED FOR INSTALLATION OF NEW OPENINGS AS SHOWN ON STRUCTURAL DRAWINGS
- 7.) IT IS LIKELY THAT "LEAD PAINT" IS PRESENT, BIDS SHOULD INDICATE REMOVING EXISTING MATERIALS THAT COULD HAVE LEAD PAINT ON
