49-51 Hancock Street, Investment Core, LLC, Federal Street Phoenix, LLC & Sunny Time Solar, LLC, owners, Tax Map 020, Block B, Lot 013, B2b Community Business Zone: The applicants are challenging the Acting Zoning Administrator's determination in an email dated January 29, 2015 that the proposed structure is an addition and not an accessory structure and therefore needs to meet the required ten foot rear setback (section 14-185). Representing the appeal were the owners. The Board of Appeals voted 6-0 to deny the appeal. The board determined that the proposed construction is a building addition and is subject to the required 10 foot rear setback.
