Dear BENGAL ENTERPRISE LLC:

An evaluation of the property at 48 Hancock Street revealed that the construction is not in accordance with the plans previously approved by the City (Permit # 2015-00033), in violation of the City of Portland Code of Ordinances § 6-16, IRC 2009 (MUBEC) R106.4. As such, the City issued a Stop Work Order on 09/28/2016 pursuant to IRC R114. Any additional work in or about the structure is prohibited.

In order to have the Stop Work Order lifted, you must 1) submit a new building permit application amending the original permit with plans bearing the seal of a licensed professional engineer that reflects the construction changes; 2) re-identify the location of the property line pins; and 3) pay the \$300 fee pursuant to § 6-17 (b)(7) of the City Code.

The performance of any work in or about the structure while a Stop Work Order is in effect is a violation and will be immediately referred to the City of Portland Corporation Counsel for legal action and civil penalties, as provided for in § 6-1 of the City Code and in 30-A M.R.S. § 4452.
