As to the design, I like it however I think you need to have some sort of relief somewhere in the body of the gate. This would break up the vertical bars. It could be achieved by repeating the header (the small circles at the top) about two thirds of the way down as I have depicted in the attached sketch. Or it could be something more ornamental as shown in the link below.
