## **Existing Fire Protection:**

The northerly existing wall of the tenant space is an existing 3HR rated assembly with a UL listing of U435. This determination is from the existing plans for the original shell/core drawings on file at city hall. The easterly and westerly facing walls are demising walls to adjacent tenant spaces. These demising walls were constructed at a later date as part of the tenant build out process. These are 1HR-demising walls. The ceiling/floor assembly above is a concrete and metal deck composite over a structural steel frame. These structural elements have all been sprayed with a fire retardant system providing a 2HR rating of the floor/ceiling assembly.

The south wall is an entry storefront system with no required rating (except for the structural columns, which are all wrapped in Type X GWB per original plans and specs for the project).

The building is fully sprinkled.

## Life Safety Plan:

Given the rather straightforward nature of the plan submittal, life safety information has been shown on the plan. No new fire rated assemblies are required Travel to the allowable singular EXIT is 45'-6" well under the allowable 100'-0" for a single EXIT space. Fire extinguishers and EXIT sign locations noted and emergency lighting is not required.
