Dear Rev. Gleason:

With regard to installation of new bake oven next to the kitchen range in small ante-room adjoining large assembly hall serving hot school lunches, we note the following:

1. The bake oven requires a permit from this department for installation.
2. The bake oven does not require a hood but the kitchen range does.
3. Both units require a vent to the outside to remove combustion fumes.
4. A hood over the range can be used to vent gases of combustion.
5. Rather than hold up the immediate necessity of school lunches, we have agreed with the Gas Company to install the bake oven on a 30 day temporary basis providing an exhaust fan is installed in the window.
6. The hood when properly designed will need a permit for the installation.

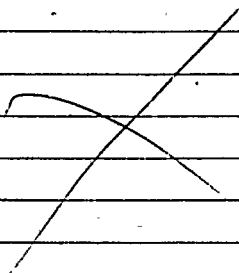
