Dear Mr. McAdam;

An evaluation of your property at 235 Congress Street on 12/1/99 revealed that the structure continues to fail to comply with the Housing Code of the City of Portland.

Attached is a list of the violations.

This is a **SECOND** notice of violation pursuant to Section 6-118 of the Code. All referenced violations shall be corrected within 30 days of the date of this notice. A re-inspection of the premises will occur on February 5, 2000 at which time compliance will be required.

Failure to comply will result in this office referring the matter to the City of Portland Corporation Counsel for legal action and possible civil penalties, as provided for in Section 1-15 of the Code and in Title 30-A M.R.S.A. ss 4452. **Please be advised that because this is the second inspection and there are repeat violations, Section 6.2 of the Code requires that you pay a \$75.00 re-inspection fee** This must be paid prior to February 5, 2000. A Certificate of Compliance will not be issued until all re-inspection fees are paid. Failure to pay the assessed fee within 30 days shall cause the City to assess a lien against the property pursuant to Section 1-16 of the Code.
