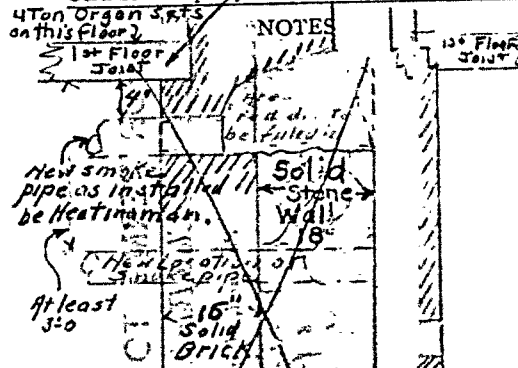

Went over this with Mr. Hennigan and Mr. Fenton, the Rector. The organ, weighing 4 tons, sets as noted above and I thought it best not to disturb the joists supporting this. Smoke pipe can be lowered as shown in red and make clearances O.K. C.B.

2/19/34. Boiler shut down

Mr. Hennigan - built at the factory through the brick stone wall

2/14/34. Mr. Hennigan sent here today. C.B.

2/15/34. I. opening cut and water running. some removing of flooring, heading off joists that have been cut and clean-cut to be put in. C.B.

2/17/34. Above work done. C.B.

2/15/34. From the C.W.A. insp. report the smoke pipe condition in the Rectory was bad. I looked this over with Mr. Fenton, the Rector, and Mr. Hennigan. It looks as though the floor joist - either side of the chimney is let in, at least, it is against the brick and but 6" above where the smoke pipe enters. There is no clear out. I recommended this be fixed at earliest convenience. C.B.
