Dear Mr. Ferrar & Mrs. Ferrar,

An evaluation of your property April 12, 2000 at the above location revealed an accumulation of rubble consisting of auto parts, tires, wood scraps etc.

It is required that all rubble be removed from the premises in accordance with Sec. 22-3(a) of the Municipal Rodent and Vermin Control Ordinance.

It was also noted that the following junked motor vehicles were present on the property:
(1-Carmin Ghia, 1-Green Dodge Van, 1-Red Ford Van)

It is required that these vehicles be removed from the premises in accordance with Sec. 12-79 of the Municipal Junked Motor Vehicle Ordinance.

A re-inspection will occur on May 26, 2000 at which time compliance will be required. Failure to comply will result in this office referring the matter to the City of Portland Corporation Counsel for legal action and possible civil penalties, as provided for in Sec. 1-15 of the Code. This constitutes an appealable decision pursuant to Sec. 22-21 of the Rodent and Vermin control code and of Sec. 12-80 of the Garbage, Waste, and junk code.
