Re: 70 Anderson Street - Design Revisions

Shukria,

Please see the attached revised design for the 70 Anderson Street project indicating the revisions we made after our meeting with you and Caitin Cameron. We have made the following revisions to the design in order to address the comments:

1.) We have raised the first floor elevation 12" to provide a raised base relationship that was requested.

2.) A base cladding material has been adde to the buildings to further emphasize the buildings base and its relationship to the pedestrian level.

3.) The sills of the first floor windows adjacent to the streets have been raised to provide privacy to the units from the street.

4.) The gable roof pitch has been increased to 8:12 giving the buildings a more vertical proportion similar to the other gable roofs in the surrounding neighborhood.

5.) A siding color contrast and slight projection at the gable end creates a vertical bay that further enhances the vertical orientation of the gable end facade.

6.) We have added projecting bays to the facades as a means to articulate the facades facing the streets.

7.) The buildings color scheme has been simplified which now consists of two major colors, one for each building.
