Steven, this application and work falls into the "shade of gray" area regarding fast track-able permitting. I discussed with our plan reviewer, Jeanie Bourke, and she agreed. Here is a fast track application. This is a program, provided in addition to your original permit application that your project is eligible for. There is no charge for this, however it does need to be read and filled out in its entirety, and then both pages need to be sent back. Typically a fast-track able permit takes @5-10 business days as opposed to the typical ones that go through the complete review process, which can take up to 20-30 business days.
