An evaluation of the property at 25 Cedar St on *February* 15, 2000 revealed that you currently inhabit the above apartment. In September of 1998, building was declared unfit for human occupancy and has not been released or declared fit as of this date. This constitutes a violation of Section 6-122 of the Housing Code of the City of Portland. (Copy Enclosed)

It is required that the dwelling unit is vacated within 24 hours. A reinspection of the premises will occur on February 17th, 2000 at which time the dwelling unit must be totally vacated and secured from vandalism. Failure to comply will result in this office referring the matter to the City of Portland Corporation Counsel for legal action and possible civil penalties, as provided for in Section 1-15 of the Code.
