Separate plans shall be submitted for a) Suppression system b) Detection System (separate permit is required) A separate Life Safety Plan must include: a) Fire resistance ratings of all means of egress b) Travel distance from most remote point to exit discharge c) Location of any required fire extinguishers d) Location of emergency lighting e) Location of exit signs f) NFPA 101 code summary Elevators shall be sized to fit an 80" x 24" stretcher. If the application is incomplete, the application may be refused. In order to be sure the City fully understands the full scope of the project, the Planning and Development Department may request additional information prior to the issuance of a permit.
