I received a request in regards to the status of Wilmot Place from Thomas Jewell, Esq. of Jewell & Bulger, P.A.

This is to supplement the Portland DPS Engineering Archives Street Records in regards to Wilmot Place.

Wilmot Place has not been accepted by the City of Portland, and is considered by the City of Portland DPS Engineering Archives to be a Private Way.

Wilmot Place is not shown on 1882 City of Portland Revaluation Plan 26. Wilmot Place is shown on City of Portland Tax Map 26 as revised through 2004.

Wilmot Place is shown on DPW Engineering Archives Vault plan 406/24 "Wilmot Street near Wilmot Place" dated November 4, 1919 as "Wilmot Place" with no defined sidelines or right-of-way limits.

Wilmot Place is not listed on the City of Portland City Council Order #84 "Order Excepting Streets From Deemed Vacation" as passed on September 3, 1997.

It is my opinion that Wilmot Place may have been named (by persons unknown) in order to provide a named location for emergency service vehicles and others to respond to. Wilmot Place provides access to Wilmot Street from apartment entrances along the southeasterly side of the apartment building at #48 Wilmot Street.
