Please let me clarify, interconnection within the 3rd floor unit is required because it is considered a "New Apartment". Hi Craig,

Per our telecon earlier today, we have added 10 hardwired smoke detectors to the 17 Westfield project. 2 in the Basement, 3 on the first floor, 3 on the second floor and 1 on the third floor per the attached T-1 PDF. The hardwired smoke detectors that we originally showed on the 3rd floor remain and are not interconnected per your requirement. A complete interconnected smoke detector system is not required and manual pull stations, etc. are **not required** for this project.

I have cc'd the alterations to Building Inspections for inclusion in the electronic file.
