



## CERTIFICATE OF FLAME RESISTANCE

Rose Brand is in business at 4 Emerson Lane, Secaucus, New Jersey with offices also at 10616 Lanark Street, Sun Valley, California.

The IFR (Inherently Flame Retardant) fabric described below meets the minimum requirements of flame resistance established by the following test:

- NFPA 701 (2010 edition), test method #1
- NFPA 701 (1989 edition), small scale test

Woven with *non-combustible filament*, this fabric is inherently and permanently flame resistant for the life of the fabric. This flame resistance will NOT wash out. Rose Brand, however, recommends annual testing of the fabric using the NFPA 705 (1997 or later) Field Test Method for Textiles, as accumulations of airborne dust and oils may diminish the flame resistance of the fabric. Cold water washing with gentle detergent followed by air drying will restore any lost flame retardance.
