Appointments must be requested 48 to 72 hours in advance of the required inspection. The inspection date will need to be confirmed by this office.

- **Permits expire in 6 months. If the project is not started or ceases for 6 months.**
- **If the inspection requirements are not followed as stated below additional fees may be incurred due to the issuance of a "Stop Work Order" and subsequent release to continue.**
- **Per Section 107.3.1 of the Maine Uniform Building and Energy Code (MUBEC). One set of printed approved stamped construction documents shall be kept at the site of work and shall be open to inspection by building officials.**

1) The sidewalk sign must be located at least 20 feet from any other sidewalk sign.				
2) All sidewalk signs shall be removed when the business is closed or while any snow or ice exists on the walkway within eight feet of the sign in any direction. All sidewalk signs shall be located near the curb rather than the building face. The sidewalk shall maintain a width of no less than 4 1/2 feet of unobstructed sidewalk width perpendicular to major flows. For a single tenant listing, the maximum width is 24 inches or less if needed to meet the 4.5 feet of unobstructed sidewalk width. The maximum height of a sidewalk sign is 40 inches to the top of the sign in place. The minimum height of a sidewalk sign is 30 inches to the top of the sign in place.				
3) This permit is being approved on the basis of plans submitted. Any deviations shall require a separate approval before starting that work.
