BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the following activities shall be held in the Monument Square, One City Center sidewalk area and Monument Way:

November 25, 2011: Tree Lighting Ceremony in Monument Square - 5:30 to 6:30 PM (rain, snow or shine); and

Hay Wagon rides Friday, November 25 from 4:00 PM to 8:00 PM and continued on Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays during the festival dates (Fridays: 4:00-8:00 PM) Saturdays (2:00 PM-6:00 PM) and Sundays (1:00 PM-5:00PM); and

- BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the Organizers will be allowed to place a 20x24' stage on Congress Street (between Preble and Elm Street) that would face out to Monument Square including closure of that section of Congress Street to vehicular traffic from 9:00 AM to 9:00 PM on Friday, November 25<sup>th</sup>; and
