- 2) Fuel-fired heating equipment and propane tanks shall be installed outside of the tents and not with 5 feet of the tents or an exit discharge.
- 3) Tents shall have an approved fire resistant rating and maintain 10' between stake lines. No smoking or open flame allowed within 10'. Provide at least one 2A:10 BC fire extinguisher.
- 4) If the sides of the tents are to be enclosed at least two remotely located and marked exits shall be provided.
- 5) All tents shall meet the flame propagation performance criteria contained in NFPA 701. A certificate or other evidence of acceptance by an organization acceptable to the AHJ shall serve as evidence that the tent fabric materials have the required flame propagation performance.
- 6) All means of egress to remain accessible at all times.
- 7) All construction shall comply with 2009 NFPA 101, Chapter 11 Special Structures and High Rise Buildings...
- 8) All construction shall comply with 2009 NFPA 1, Fire Code. Review and approval by the AHJ shall not relieve the applicant of the responsibility of compliance with this Code (Chapter 1.14.4).
