The Department of Public Works will permit a *twenty-five gallon per minute* passive grease interceptor to be installed, in "Anthony's Cafe" space, instead of an Automatic Grease Removal Unit, as originally proposed, by Mr. Bartrasso.

Keep in mind that any change of Food Service Establishment ownership, in the future, will subject the new owners to review of the grease interceptor, in light of their proposed business activities. This could result in an upgrade of the grease interceptor to an Automatice Grease Removal Unit.
