Rob forwarded on your email and answers to your questions are below in bold:

1) Regarding the small canopy over the new entry door facing Hampshire St, will this be extending over the city road right of way? It appears that it will be, but there was no survey included so I could not confirm. If so, there is a licensing process for structures over city property that you will need to complete.

**We are assuming that this is extending over city property and will pursue the avenue of the licensing that you are referencing.**

2) Is the plan still to park two cars under the deck, plus another in the driveway next to the deck? As we discussed via e-mail previously, the number of parking spaces on the lot cannot be reduced, so I just wanted to confirm that this still is the plan.

**That is correct, the deck is designed to accommodate existing parking while working within the buildable envelope on the site.**
