PRE INSTALLATION CRITERIA

1.0 GENERAL

- 1.1. "Pre-Installation" and / or "Pre-Placement" meetings shall be held, at the project site, prior to the installation of work which require coordination, special installation, testing and / or controlled procedures.

These meetings shall include, but not necessarily be limited to the following:

- A. **PRE-START-UP MEETING**
- B. Pre – Site – Demolition / Clearing / Excavation / Grading / etc.
- C. Pre-foundation placement
- D. Pre-slab placement
All footing excavation shall be inspected prior to placement.
- E. Pre-placement - Sitework Concrete
All below slab excavations, vapor barriers, and fill shall be inspected as described in 01010 prior to placement of Concrete.
- F. Pre-Framing – Steel Frame
- G. A Pre – skin meeting to coordinate the entire skin construction with all related trades including, but not limited to, framing, prefabricated panels, masonry, siding, sealants, windows, MEP/FP (penetrations), etc. Refer to Section 01050 .
- H. Pre – Pre-cast
- I. Pre – Masonry
- J. Pre- Insulation
- K. Pre – Gypsum Wall Systems
- L. Pre- Plumbing / Mechanical / Electrical / Fire Protection
[May be one or several meetings.]
- M. Pre- Roofing [All roofing trades – shingles, metal, etc.]
- N. Pre-Finishing [drywall, painter, VWC, specialty finishes, etc.]
- O. Pre-Landscaping [sidewalks, irrigation, utilities, etc.]

- 1.2. These meetings shall include the following individuals and others as may be necessary.

- A. The attendees shall include:

General Contractor	Project Manager and Superintendent
Subcontractor (s)	Sub Owner and Foreman
Material Supplier	Supplier Owner
Material Manufacturer	Technical Representative
Designer	Structural Engineer and/or Architect
Design / Build Systems	Subcontractor Engineer(s)
Testing Agency	Engineer with training in the specific trade.
Owner Representative	(Optional)
- B. See individual Specification sections for more specifics.

- 1.3. The Pre-meetings shall be conducted and minutes shall be maintained by the General Contractor and distributed to all parties within 3 business days, or prior to work commencing (relative to the pre-meeting), whichever is earlier. These minutes shall serve as the installation guide for the trade.
