STONE COUNTERTOPS

PART 1 - GENERAL

- 1.1. Granite countertops are to be Furnished and Installed by the General Contractor at the following locations:
 - A. Granite countertops in the toilet rooms.
 - B. Alternate: Granite countertops in kitchenettes.

1.2. QUALITY ASSURANCE

- A. Single-Source Responsibility.
- 1. Stone: Obtain each color, grade, finish, type, and variety of stone from a single quarry with resources to provide materials of consistent quality in appearance and physical properties, including the capacity to cut and finish material without delaying the progress of the work.
- 2. Mortar and Grout Materials: Obtain mortar ingredients of uniform quality and from one manufacturer for each cementitious and admixture component and from one source or producer for each aggregate.
- 3. Other Materials: Obtain each type of stone accessory, sealant, and other materials from one manufacturer for each product.

B. MATERIALS, GENERAL

- 1. Comply with referenced standards and other requirements indicated applicable to each type of material required. For Granite countertops, comply with recommendations of Granite Building Stone Standard ASTM C-568 and National Building Granite Quarries Association (NBGQA) Specifications for Architectural Granite.
- 2. Provide matched blocks from a single quarry for each type, variety, color, and quality of stone required. Extract blocks from a single bed of quarry stratum especially reserved for project, unless stones from randomly selected blocks are acceptable to Owner's Representative for aesthetic effect.
- 3. Quarry stone in manner to ensure that as-quarried block orientations yield finished stone with required characteristics.

- 2.2. Products and Colors: Tier 2 quality.
- 2.3. Adhesives and Sealants
 - 1. General: Use only adhesives formulated for stone and ceramic tile and recommended by their manufacturer for the application indicated.
 - 2. Water-cleanable Epoxy Adhesive: ANSI A118.3
 - 3. Sealant for Countertops: colored silicone sealant with flex color to match stone, complying with requirements of Division 7 Section "Sealants".

PART 3 - EXECUTION:

- 3.1. Installation provide additional support and blocking in walls to carry the Granite and Marble.

 A. Contractor shall Furnish and install all granite.
- 3.2. Fabrication:
 - A. Fabricate stone countertops in sizes and shapes required to comply with requirements indicated, including details on Drawings and Shop Drawings.
 - B. Provide thickness indicated, but not less than 1 1/4" Nominal Thickness (4"x3/4" at backsplash). Cabinets to be reinforced as required and refer to interior elevations
 - C. Edge Detail: Provide "Bullnose" edge detail top and bottom. Provide polished eased edges at all sink cutouts for mounting of under mount type sinks.
 - D. Sizes may vary to fit cabinets. Refer to drawings and confirm in shop drawings.
