### Fire Department requirements.

The following shall be submitted on a separate sheet:

- Name, address and phone number of applicant **and** the project architect.
- Proposed use of structure (NFPA and IBC classification)
- Square footage of proposed structure (total and per story)
- Existing and proposed fire protection of structure.
- Separate plans shall be submitted for
  - a) Suppression system
  - b) Detection System (separate permit is required)
- A separate Life Safety Plan must include:
  - a) Fire resistance ratings of all means of egress
  - b) Travel distance from most remote point to exit discharge
  - c) Location of any required fire extinguishers d)  
Location of emergency lighting
  - e) Location of exit signs
  - f) NFPA 101 code summary
- Elevators shall be sized to fit an 80" x 24" stretcher.

**Please submit all of the information outlined in this application checklist. If the application is incomplete, the application may be refused.**

In order to be sure the City fully understands the full scope of the project, the Planning and Development Department may request additional information prior to the issuance of a permit.
