LICENSE AGREEMENT made this _	day of	, 2017, by and

Congress St., located in the State of Maine, (h	ereinafter the "City") and	Williams-
Sonoma Stores, Inc., a California corporation	(hereinafter the "Licensee"	").

WHEREAS, Licensee leases certain space located at 164 Middle Street, Portland, Maine, and in connection with certain work, Licensee wishes to install a canopy connected with a building permit application, a diagram of which is attached as Exhibit A, in the following location:

(the "Installation"); and

WHEREAS, said Installation is located within CITY's right-of way;

NOW THEREFORE, the parties hereby agree as follows:

- 1. The **CITY** hereby grants to **Licensee** a revocable license to install and maintain the **Installation** within the **City**'s right-of-way as described above;
- 2. It is the responsibility and duty of **Licensee** to obtain all necessary approvals and permits, to the extent that such approvals and permits are required.
- 3. Licensee covenants and agrees to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the City, its officers and employees, from and against any and all damages, acts, causes of action, claims and demands of any nature or kind whatsoever, whether for personal injury, including death, or property damage, and costs, including reasonable attorney's fees and costs of defense, which in whole or in part arise out of or result from the installation, maintenance, and/or operation of the Installation permitted hereunder, regardless of whether such claim, damage, loss or expense is caused in part by any party indemnified hereunder.
- 4. Licensee shall provide the City with a certificate of insurance evidencing comprehensive general liability coverage in an amount no less than \$400,000 combined single limit, for personal injury and property damage, covering the obligation of indemnification hereunder and naming the City as an additional insured thereon. Said certificate shall provide that no less than 30 days prior written notice shall be provided to City prior to non-renewal or cancellation of said policy. Said insurance shall be primary to any insurance or self-insurance maintained by City. This provision shall not waive the City's immunities and

defenses under the Maine Tort Claims Act, 14 M.R.S. § 8101 et seq.

- 5. Licensee shall be responsible for all maintenance and repair of the Installation, including keeping the Installation in safe condition. Licensee acknowledges that the Installation may become damaged and that the City shall not be held liable for any damages, maintenance or repair of said Installation.
- 6. **Licensee** shall not assign or otherwise transfer its rights hereunder except upon the approval of **City**, which approval shall not be unreasonably withheld.
- 7. This License is revocable by **City** at its sole discretion, upon one month's written notice, and shall automatically terminate in the event that the location with which the Installation is associated no longer exists at the site.
- 8. Licensee agrees that it is responsible for repairing any damage to City property arising out of or resulting from the Installation or activities related to the Installation.
